Who Can Apply:

This position is available for **individuals ages 15-30** as a part of the Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) initiative. This position is paid for through the CSJ initiative to help give students experience working in roles that might not otherwise be available to them. Applicants must have Canadian Citizenship, be a permanent resident, or have been granted refugee status in Canada.

Duration/Hours of Work/Compensation:

This position is funded through Canada Summer Jobs. This position is for 9 weeks of employment, 30 hours/week at a rate of \$17.55/hour. Start Date would be for the last week of June or the first week of July and run until the end of August.

The Internship Supervisor and summer interns will work together to create a weekly work schedule. Please note: Flexibility is important. The position includes working on Sunday mornings as well as working occasional evenings.

 A relationship with Jesus Christ and be actively involved in a program/study that encourages Christian growth (e.g. being a regular part of a church, being a part of a small group, or enrolled in Bible College)

- Demonstrate creativity and a willingness to take risks and dream
- Good communication skills, enthusiastic, self-starter/independent thinker
- Organized yet relational
- Must abide by dress code standards
- Computer knowledge and experience with technology an asset (Microsoft, CANVA, experience or interest in livestreaming or projection)
- Public speaking ability an asset
- Musical ability (playing an instrument, singing, leading action songs for kids) an asset
